

Agile Essentials

Working with Agile methods is a way to shorten the time from the development of an idea to a completed product. Typically, this involves closer interaction with the customer and has a positive impact on both the organisation and the way of working.



Training Overview

The training teaches the essential concepts of Agile through the implementation of Scrum method. Scrum is the most popular and widely implemented Agile project management approach. The training also discusses the principles of implementing Scrum, different roles and their interactions, tools and deliverables of the Scrum team and governance in Scrum. Participants will explore these topics through classroom discussions and Agile games.

Training Objectives

At the end of the training, trainees will have a clear understanding about the following:

- The state of the art of Agile method
- Common practices in Agile and Scrum
- Why Agile software development works?
