# Scrum Master with PSM I Certification



Projects are increasingly choosing an Agile approach and Scrum is the most popular. Their main drivers are to produce software faster and cheaper but also to better align the business and users with the development team.

### **Training Overview**

This training details agile processes and team dynamics, with a strong emphasis on the role of Scrum Master. It covers the benefits of working in Scrum, highlighting the differences between Scrum and traditional development methodologies. Practical exercises enable the understanding of the power of visual management and pursuing and resolving impediments.

The training concludes with the PSM I exam, provided by scrum.org. This certification was created in 2009 by Ken Schwaber, one of the founders of Scrum.

## **Training Objectives**

This training takes an interactive approach to teach trainees to guide a team, a project or an organisation into a process of rapid delivery. Exercises, case studies and examples are used to assist in developing the knowledge, skills, capabilities and insights needed to shift from the traditional software development practices to the Agile approach.

At the end of the training, trainees have a clear understanding about the following:

- Why adopt Agile and Scrum?
- Principles and different roles and responsibilities in Scrum
- Implementing Agile practices for estimation, planning, project execution and monitoring
- Facilitating Scrum ceremonies and foster product quality

## **Target Audience**

This training is intended for project managers, team leads, designers, developers, testers, software architects and anyone who is expected to lead Scrum projects and teams.

Participants should have some basic knowledge about Agile and Scrum and want to deepen their knowledge about the Scrum framework and its applications.
