## Training Overview

During this training, gain an in-depth understanding of the ART, how it delivers value, and what you can do to effectively perform your role using Scrum, Kanban, and XP. Learn how to write stories and break down features, plan and execute iterations and plan Programme Increments. Finally, learn about the continuous delivery pipeline and DevOps culture, how to effectively integrate with other teams in the program and what it takes to continuously improve the train.

To perform the role of a SAFe® Practitioner, attendees should be able to:

- Apply SAFe® to scale Lean and Agile development in their enterprise
- Know their team and its role on the Agile Release Train
- Know all other teams on the Train, their roles and the dependencies between the teams
- Plan iterations

- Plan Programme Increments
- Integrate and work with other teams on the Train
